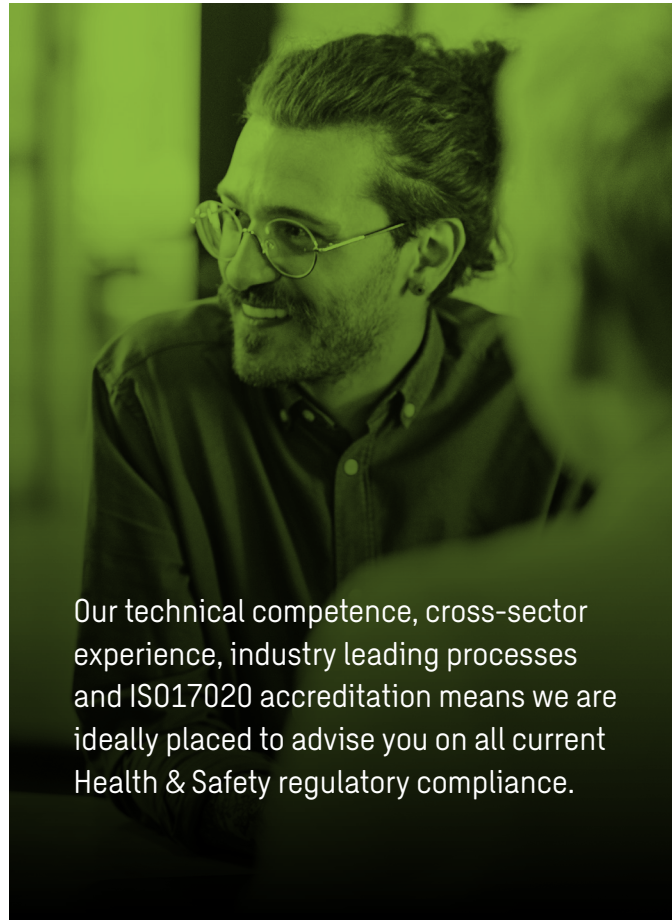

- ✓ Advise the client on the suitability of the Principal Contractor's Initial Construction Phase Plan and ensure that appropriate welfare facilities will be provided during the construction phase.
- ✓ Carry out CDM Site Inspection(s) and report to the Client and Principal Contractor.
- ✓ Review the Health and Safety File on completion of the works.

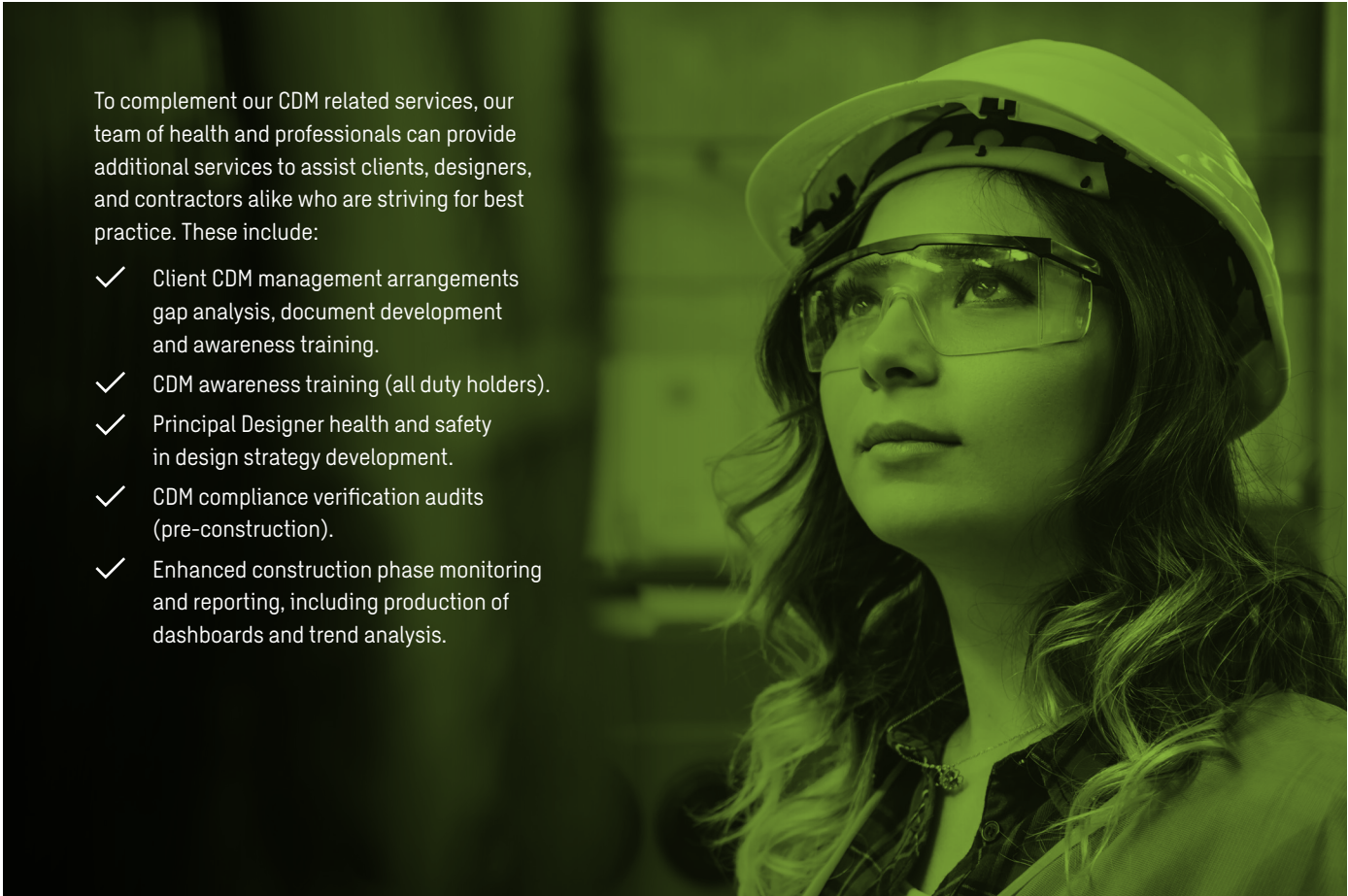
